

Policy

The Imara MET Income Fund is an enhanced income portfolio. The investment objective of the portfolio is to provide investors with a high level of income combined with capital preservation. Investments to be included in the portfolio may, apart from assets in liquid form, consist of equity and non equity securities, fixed interest instruments (including, but not limited to, bonds, corporate bonds, inflation linked bonds, convertible bonds, cash deposits and money market instruments), debentures, preference shares and property securities as well as any other income enhancing securities which are considered consistent with the portfolio's primary objective and that the Act may allow from time to time. The portfolio's equity exposure will be limited a maximum of 10% of the portfolio's asset value. The portfolio may from time to time invest in financial instruments, in accordance with the provisions of the Act and applicable legislation, as amended from time to time, in order to achieve the portfolio's investment objective. The manager may also include forward currency, interest rate and exchange rate swap transactions for efficient portfolio management purposes.
